WIS 20 RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (ROOSEVELT AVENUE TO WEST BOULEVARD)

March 18, 2021

WIS 20 TRAFFIC SWITCH

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has begun the WIS 20 (Washington Avenue) reconstruction project. The following work is scheduled for the first phase of this project.

Beginning Monday, March 22, by 5 p.m.:

- Traffic on WIS 20, between Roosevelt Avenue and West Boulevard, is scheduled to be shifted north onto the current westbound lanes through mid-summer.
- WIS 20 westbound traffic, between West Boulevard and Ohio Street, is scheduled to close to through traffic and will remain closed through early fall.
- Traffic on Ohio Street, between Linderman Avenue and 13th Street, is scheduled to be shifted west onto the current southbound lanes through early summer, with one lane of traffic in each direction.
- Traffic on West Boulevard, between Linderman Avenue and 13th Street, is scheduled to be shifted east onto the current northbound lanes through early summer, with one lane of traffic in each direction.

The following streets south of WIS 20 are scheduled to close to through traffic through early summer:

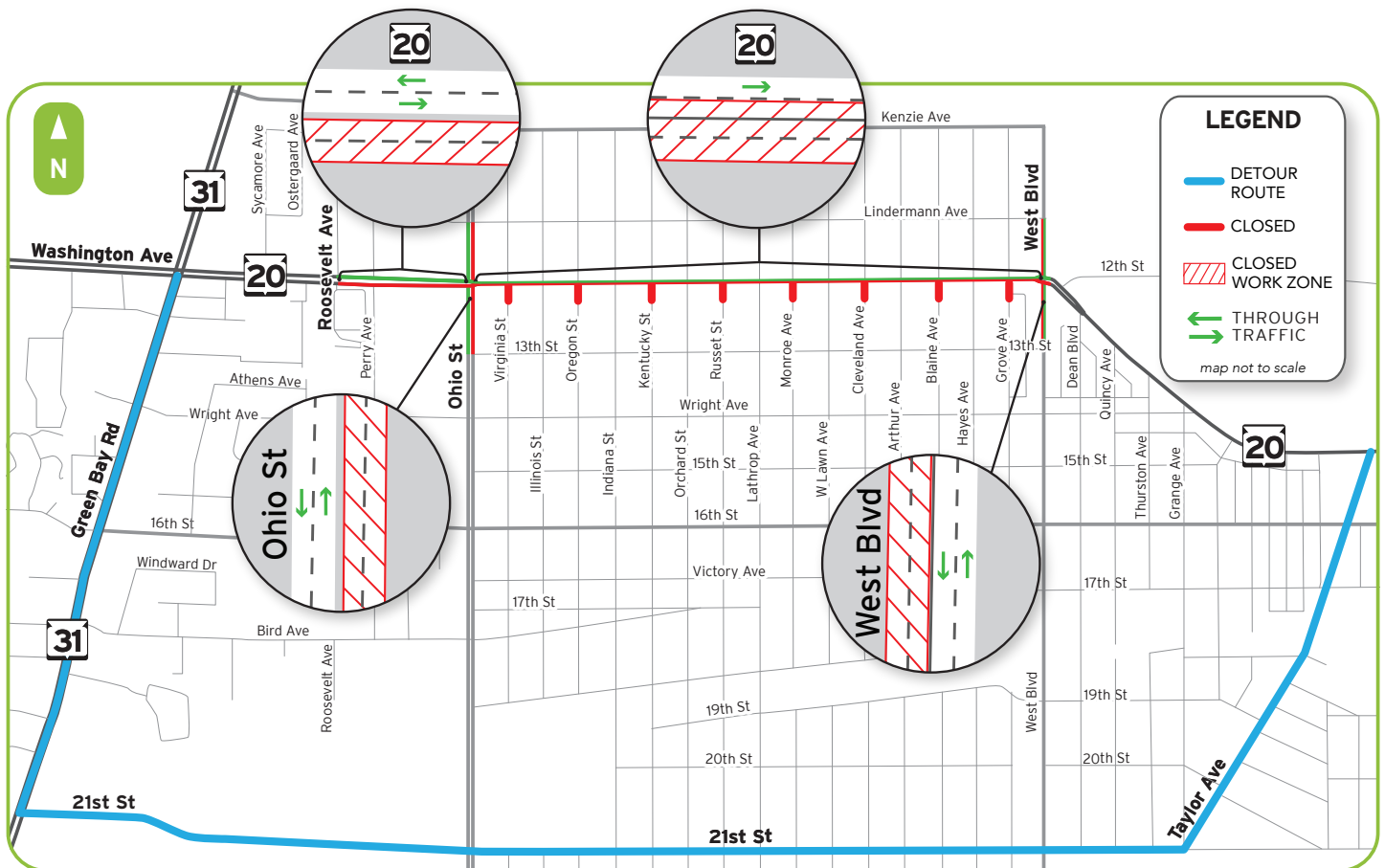
- Perry Avenue, Virginia, Oregon, Kentucky, and Russet streets, and Monroe, Cleveland, Blaine, and Grove avenues.

Detour Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to use Taylor Avenue, 21st Street, WIS 31, and WIS 20 to get around the closures.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
