At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis

I used **Psalm 40:17** as the basis for last Sunday’s Prayer of Supplication and it has continued to occupy my thoughts this past week.

But I am poor and needy; Yet the Lord thinks upon me.

You are my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.

But I am poor and needy; This describes our state. *Needy* and without the resources to do anything about it (for we are *poor*).

Yet the Lord thinks upon me Much in the style of Lamentations 3, there is a change in the dire situation found in the attention and intervention of God (for there are no redeemable resources within ourselves). As we live life and are inevitably reminded of our weaknesses and vulnerabilities at times, it is quite unsettling and, in the midst of such times, it seems scary and lonely. Yet, even when we feel isolated, we are not forgotten, for *the Lord thinks upon me*. With such a state of affairs, it is a wondrous encouragement and tremendous provision that the following is said of our God:

You are my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.

Realizing that we are needy and incapable of doing anything to rectify our situation, what a blessing that God Himself is our help! Oftentimes, our concept of rescue lies in thought of being delivered from whatever we undesirable. Yet such a scenario leaves us void of need and therefore requiring no aid from God who is here described as our *help and deliverer*. Such a fictitious situation would cause us to think ourselves not poor and needy, and without dependence upon God’s thoughts honoring us and imparting to us His grace, for our pleasant present circumstances would reason self-reliance is sufficient and God an elective accessory. What a kindness for God to keep us from such a delusion! May we thank Him for His generous provision for our expansive need!
