**At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis**

My mind has again been drawn to the Beatitudes Jesus Christ outlines in **Matthew 5**. These have come to mind, in large part, because they speak of the kingdom standards of God that show themselves to be quite upside down from the standards of our world and whose skewed views we are prone to adopt. The Beatitudes speak of blessing that comes to acknowledging the reality of our state.

We are called to acknowledge our spiritual bankruptcy before God (that we are *poor in spirit*). But this is not an admission of despair, for we find that such is the prerequisite to receive *the kingdom of heaven* as salvation is neither sought nor received apart from recognizing this reality.

Still, we rightly *mourn* over our sin and thus respond appropriately for we grasp, at least in part, the weightiness of sin evidenced by the great cost in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ to make atonement. Yet, such mourning is met with *comfort* as our sins are forgiven and we are raised to a right standing with God that we will enjoy throughout eternity.

Contrary to the clout and deference granted the mighty, our Lord calls those *blessed* who are *meek*. In ways, a logical pairing with the humility that accompanies those who mourn over their sin (from the previous verse), though in adopting such a stance, we put ourselves in a position where we are at the mercy of others. Still, the one who governs themselves according to the teachings of our Lord (these Beatitudes being a concise example) seeks to conduct themselves in accordance with the directives and standards of our Heavenly Father seeking to please Him alone.

This one is consumed (as with *hunger and thirst*) for *righteousness* and, with such a focus, follow steadily after such things and are *filled* finding the Lord and His ways fulfilling and gratifying to the soul.

May it be found in this place a people whose lives are thus defined and *merciful, pure in heart, peacemakers*, and, should the Lord will it, even *those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake*.
