At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis

Thank you for your regular involvement with and support of our missionaries. It was fun to get together to celebrate with a remote baby shower. Thank you for your pictures, notes, and gifts. I am sure they will be a big encouragement to this family and a unique way to be meaningfully connected.

Ramadan began this past Friday. It spans a month and is a holy time of the year for Muslims with much prayer and fasting. I was thinking about our missionaries as it relates to this time of year. For a solid handful of our missionaries, Ramadan will be a significant part of their year as it relates to the people they love and serve. Today, there are around two billion people who ascribe to the Islamic faith. Such numbers lead many to fear and regard them as the enemy when they are not, but rather captives of the enemy.

2nd Corinthians 4:1-6

¹ Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart. ² But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. ³ But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, ⁴ whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. ⁵ For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. ⁶ For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

⁷ But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

So for these ones we must pray as we continue to uphold our missionaries ministering in their midst. There are prayer guides for the month of Ramadan placed in the Mission Information rack in the Connection Center. There are sets for adults and for kids to involve the whole family. I hope you will take advantage of this time for prayer — allowing our hearts to be shaped to be more like God's.
