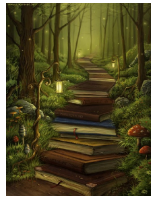


A Walk in the Books

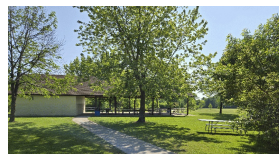

At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis

This is a big week at CMC with Vacation Bible School filling the week. We look forward to the week of VBS and it is an endeavor with preparations taking place year-round.

I thought it would be helpful to layout daily prayer points for all of us to be in prayer for this ministry throughout the week and asked Cassy Gauthier if she could forward me some ideas. I have this set up for daily prayer focusing on different areas.

└ *Monday* - the clear presentation of the Gospel each day and receptive hearts to respond in faith

Ezekiel 36:26 – *I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.*

└ *Tuesday* - for workers to purposefully, meaningfully, and lovingly connect with the kids and point them to Jesus Christ

John 13:35 – *“By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”*

└ *Wednesday* - for fruitful conversations among the families surrounding the lessons taught through the various aspects of VBS and that the Lord would use these to draw people to Himself.

Deuteronomy 6:7 – *You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.*

└ *Thursday* - for the workers to persevere and serve the children with grace

1st Corinthians 15:58 – *Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.*

└ *Friday* - for creativity and cheerfulness when encountering challenges

James 1:2-5 – ² *My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,* ³ *knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.* ⁴ *But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.* ⁵ *If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.*

The above can also be used to pray for the individuals in our church working with Child Evangelism Fellowship this summer. Chloe Wegner and Landon Wenzel are summer missionaries with CEF this summer and we can encourage them with our prayers and support.
