28 Children (3 yrs old – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade) took the challenge. Seven more 'hikers' completed their goal, bringing the total number to 17:

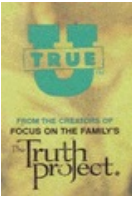

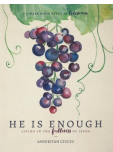

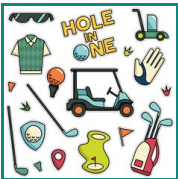
