While the buzz from this weekend is appropriately the candidacy weekend for Isaac Soriano, I wanted to speak to the matter of finances at CMC that are of timely importance.

Missions Conference 2025

This year we have had the privilege to have a number of our international missions in town throughout the Summer and into the Fall. To give special time to each, we have had our Come and See Sundays focused on a particular missionary family. We receive an offering at Missions Conference that is distributed to each of the participating missionaries and the case is the same this year, but with Missions Conference not being a concentrated week this year, the offering has been received intermittently. I mention this so you can have it in mind to give to Missions Conference and encourage these missionaries with a financial gift. Those funds will be received into October.

Anniversary Offering

Last year's and this year's anniversary offering have been and will be dedicated toward the window project. This has enabled the Facilities Committee to move forward with phase 1 of the project, expected to commence September 29. The 1st phase will allow us to replace all the exterior windows, excluding the windows on the east wall of the sanctuary. This is a significant effort to have accomplished in a relatively short amount of time thanks to the generous giving to date. But the work is only half-way done! The interior (courtyard-facing) and the sanctuary windows are next in line. It will take a comparable amount of money to complete that part of the project. I mention this so that you can plan your giving for the Anniversary Offering. The winter season is coming quickly and every dollar we put into securing new windows will translate into heating savings. Thank you for your generosity!
