


Elders are available for prayer in the front of the sanctuary at the close of the service.

**Security Reminder**—When coming to the church building at any time, please remember to lock your car doors.


**Prayer Bulletins** are available at the Ushers' table in the foyer. They are updated regularly as needed.

### **At Calvary . . . with Pastor Davis**

Contemplating nuggets from reading Job:

**1:1** – Job was blameless and upright, and one who feared God and shunned evil.

Those descriptions are quite interrelated, aren't they? *Blameless* because he *feared God* and, because he *feared God*, he *shunned evil*, therefore he was *upright*. Clear direction there. Any breakdown in that process leads to a breakdown in being *blameless and upright*. (If I fail to fear God or do not shun what is evil.)

**1:5** – What is enviable about Job: his stuff, or his devotion to the Lord? More than just having a happy family who enjoyed being together, he advocated for his children before the Lord (concerned about what was most important). *Thus Job did regularly*.

**1:9-12 & 2:4-6** – Ever the snotty accuser and lousy predictor, Satan hurls accusations and projects an outcome, but is powerless to do anything without permission or cooperation. Leveraging either bounty (as with Job)

or implying lack (as with Adam & Eve) as basis for rebellion or devotion, the evil one seeks to draw people away from the Lord. His works are evident in that he ever seeks to destroy, ruin, and kill. Whereas nothing is outside of the knowledge and control of our Heavenly Father and we are never outside of His care.

I wonder why the account of Job is so distressing.

■ Surely the extent of his sufferings are horrifying and not somewhere we would like to go in our minds.

*For the thing I greatly feared has come upon me,  
And what I dreaded has happened to me. (3:25)*

■ The counsel of Job's friends is troubling, but probably not for the reasons that it should be. I admit that a lot of what they said makes a lot of sense to me. Much of their argumentation fits with the way that I think. Many of their points come from the belief that we do good and we get good. There is certainly scriptural basis for such cause and effect, but the implication is that the good we have is due to the good we have done (and therefore every bad thing is tied to a bad thing that was done). This forms a solid basis for pride and finger-pointing. In doing so, they speak to more than they know. They are unaware of what is transpiring behind the scenes and are overly confident and wrongly so. Yet another reminder of the sound counsel of **Proverbs 10:19**:

*In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, But he who restrains his lips is wise.*

What are you learning? Strike up a conversation with someone this morning and ask what they have been learning from their Bible reading and let us take our interaction with one another to a more meaningful level and grow together. Such exchanges will further the purpose of our church family Bible reading, a fine application of this month's Bible verse from **Psalm 1:1-2**, and encourage us to be *blameless and upright, . . . who [fear] God and [shun] evil*.
