At Calvary . . . following up with Missions

I see in you such great participation in knowing and praying for our missionaries. They are not unknown, out-of-sight-out-of-mind entities here and I am very grateful. I have received responses from a number of our missionaries and wanted to pass along some of that information to you.

■ A thank you note for the church family is available on the bulletin board at the top of the stairs of the large canopy entrance (where such things are posted – for future reference). Though they all got hit with a round of the flu, they are pleased to be back together as a family and settling into a new setting.

■ To help our missionaries plan their finances/budget, Miz Linda sent out notices when they can expect those funds throughout the year. We were able to reallocate funds and give “raises” to a handful of our missionaries. It has been a blessing for the Missions Committee and our missionaries to be able to give increases to growing families. Through responses we received, our missionaries noticed and are very grateful for God’s provision through the faithful support of His people.

■ Harvest Outreach sent a summary of the involvement CMC has had in that ministry throughout the last year. 3,423 pounds of food donated and over five thousand dollars in financial support, and faithful weekly workers help make it possible for them to serve 6,772 in 2025. That is wonderful! Thank you again for faithfully contributing to the needs in our community that they might be reached with the Gospel through the avenue of providing needed food.

■ If you have not already noticed, I wanted to draw your attention to the wall between the Connection Center and nursery where we have pictures of our missionaries. Many of those have been recently updated. It is pretty amazing to see how God has filled up and grown up these families. I hope that you take notice of these dear ones and continue to grow in your affection and prayer-filled care for them.

■ I remind you to make use of the prayer bulletins in the foyer to keep up-to-date with those in our CMC missionary family (as well as the other ministries of our church and branches of our government).
