## At Calvary . . . with CMC sharing reflections from the book of Job

“Job’s friends, specifically in **Job 8** but throughout, adhere to the Faith Formula theology, Prosperity Gospel—if you are pure and sinless then you will prosper, but if you sin you are afflicted. It is human nature to think that way. Yet if we would take but a minute and reflect on the afflicted lives of the Apostles we would have to conclude that they didn’t get the message. They acknowledged they were still sinners but saved by Grace. Jesus turned the world upside down and we are so, so, so grateful for that.”

**8:13-14** – “Don’t trust in what is fragile (connection to Psalm 20:7).”

**9:4-10** – “A beautiful description of our Almighty God.”

**9:14-15** – “Can’t dispute or argue, we can only plead for mercy.”

**13:15** – “Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him.” Whatever God brings into my life, I am to trust Him.”

**16:2** – “Miserable comforters are ye all.” There is time to comfort and a time to confront!”

**16:19** – “My Advocate is on high.”

**19:25** – “My redeemer lives.”

**23:12** – “I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food.’ Is this true of me?”

**32:1** – “Job was a blameless and upright man but had an attitude problem just like the prodigal son’s brother [Luke 15:29] – Father, you owe me. I have been blameless and upright and you owe me goodness and mercy.”

**36:4** – “One who is perfect in knowledge is with you.” God knows why things happen (though we may not) and promises His presence.”

“What was impressed upon me on this study of Job was we are declared righteous by God’s love alone and not by our goodness or works. [Eph. 2:8]”

“The long conversations back and forth argue that we deserve reward or punishment for our good or bad deeds and that’s what justifies us before God. That is the struggle we have with justification by works. God you owe me.”

“Job has a warning for Christians. Do I have that attitude? Am I trusting in my “goodness, religion” or am I responding to Him with gratitude and obedience. We live in a fallen world that can overwhelm us. But He is my father, He loves me and has overcome that world. My shepherd will take good care of me [Psalm 23].”

“Most look at the story of Job as a way to decipher whether God is just or unjust by the specifics of the story. Actually, the lesson is never explained even by God himself. The fact that his friends thought they knew why God would allow these things to happen to Job represents today what I think of most religions. God does not save by works. The gate is small and most will not enter. By grace we are saved through faith not by works. Don’t try to understand his plan for us, just be his child and let him lead. Be thankful he is Omnipotent, Omniscient, and Omnipresent.”
