At Calvary . . .

Brothers and Sisters in Christ, this past Sunday, March 1, you all may have heard or felt a loud bang during communion. This turned out to be an issue with one of our gas boilers located in the basement of our building. Upon inspection, there was no damage to the building and the boiler itself was inspected and found to be intact. The boiler was disabled immediately and does not present any imminent risk. The issue appears to be a faulty valve that allowed gas to build up in the combustion chamber and create a situation where at time of the ignition of the boiler, the built-up gas ignited and caused the loud noise that you may have heard Sunday.

The boilers do receive attention on a weekly basis and Facilities has been addressing concerns noted. We give this issue priority. We have qualified boiler technicians that have inspected the entire boiler for any safety risks, and we have instructed them to correct all irregularities noted. Our main boilers are both thirty-one years old and have been operating as expected (this issue excluded) for many years. The life of the boilers, per these technicians, can be up to 50 years with the proper care.

We will resolve the faulty valve situation and start the process to evaluate replacement options and their costs. I apologize for any concern this may have caused but take comfort knowing that our forefathers built a sturdy building that could manage issues such as this. I would appreciate prayers for safety for the workers looking at this issue and sound guidance in steering us in the right direction. Please pray for our Facilities Committee to be given wisdom and discernment in seeking the appropriate boilers for our church.
