At Calvary . . . with CMC's reflections on the book of Genesis

24:20 – "So she quickly emptied her jar into the trough, ran back to the well to draw more water, and drew enough for all his camels." Rebekah RAN to serve. She did not serve grudgingly.

(vs 28 she also ran to tell her mother, so maybe she was just fast!) haha

24:27 – (on Eliezer finding a wife for Isaac) "As for me, being on the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren." Eliezer had started his journey in obedience before God led him to Rebekah. Before we can expect God to lead us, we need to be sure we are walking in a way that pleases Him.

39:9 – When Joseph was presented with an opportunity to sin, he recognized that the wickedness was a sin against God and not just the people he would wrong. When others wronged him, (vs 21) the Lord was with him and showed him kindness. Our choices may not always have our desired outcome, but having God still with us and showing us kindness far outweighs the short-term 'fun' of sin.

45:5 & 7 – Joseph looked back and saw "God sent me ahead of you to save your lives by a great deliverance." This is how God works - He works ahead of us and provides a great deliverance (whether in this world or ultimately heaven).

50:7-10 – When Jacob's sons carried his body to Canaan for burial, they were in the midst of the Promised Land. All but their children and livestock made the trip. Seems it would've been the right time for them to return, but that wasn't God's plan.

God's timing often differs from what we believe is best. Who wouldn't want to avoid difficult times and circumstances? He still uses afflictions accomplish His purposes in our lives, and we'll grow if we endure them with patience and trust in His unfailing love and kindness.
