At Calvary . . . with CMC's reflections on the book of Exodus

6:6-8 - “everything He's going to do could only be of Him, followed by vs 9 - where Moses reports to the Israelites, but they don't listen because of their discouragement. Sometimes discouragement prevents us from accepting truth, but it isn't any less true.”

20:20 - “...so that the fear of God will keep you from sinning.’ What a blessing!”

23:2 - “Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong.”

24:10-11 - “The Greek suggests that they saw some form of His glory and eating and drinking with God implied God's acceptance of their presence on the mountain. Even Moses was separated from God by a cloud and was called by God's voice. Moses was restrained from seeing God's face, but was exposed to His glory by God's calling to him on the 7th day from the midst of the cloud. The Israelites witnessed God's glory from the bottom of the mountain, Moses experienced His glory firsthand at the top and would continue to experience that fellowship with God after the tabernacle was constructed.

“Fast forward to today - God has provided a Helper, the Holy Spirit to be with each believer. The veil that separated us and Moses from God has been removed and we now live with Christ in each of us. What an immeasurable He has given to us. No further interpretation required.”



Exodus 25 notes a change: an unapproachable God is making Himself approachable. **John 1:14** resolves it: “The Word became flesh and tabernacled among us.”

“The passage is **31:1-6** and is repeated somewhat in **35:30-35** but the key phrases are in **31:2-3**: ‘I have called...., and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship....’ We often wonder how could the Israelites have built that glorious tabernacle in the wilderness? The bottom line answer is they couldn't have done so on their own. But God! Just as He did in the wilderness (and throughout history), God does not call the qualified, He qualifies the called. Do we answer, ‘Yes’ when He calls us or do we balk and argue that we can't do it then say ‘send someone else’ like Moses did in **4:13**? However, when He calls us to do something, our initial reaction should be that we can't do it...because it is only through His grace, strength and power that we can do anything that He calls us to do. As Paul reminded the Corinthian church in **1 Cor. 12:9**, ‘He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.”’ He went on to say at the end of **vs 10**, ‘For when I am weak, then I am strong.’ As many are wont to do, I’m tempted to plug in **Phil. 4:13** here, but Paul is talking about being content in his circumstances...with God’s provision...when he says, ‘I can do all things through him who strengthens me.’ ...he’s not referring to his ability to accomplish tasks that God has called him to do...although it could be inferred. Anyway, we can’t be paralyzed by our fear of our abilities...inabilities...because, if in fact, God has called us to do something, He will enable us to do it.

“Going along with this, we need to celebrate the different callings He gives to various people in the church and not be envious of what He has called other people to do. I just need to do what He has called me to do and thank others for what He has called them to do...and also encourage them along the way. One thing of note though...everyone has gifts that God has and is calling each of us to use for His glory, the good of His church and for our own good as well...He hasn't called spectators.”
