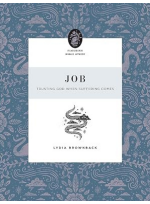

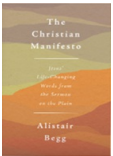

Some encouragements for you to put on your “to do list” as we get back into another school year:

- ✓ **Schedule your Bible reading into each day.**
I would encourage you to start your day with God’s Word to set the course for your day. Rather than starting your day with the anxieties of the day waiting in your inbox or the ups and downs of the day’s news, begin your day with a heavenly perspective and a reminder that God is sovereignly in control and desiring a relationship with you. No other interest is more important or worthy of your worship. First things first. Pick up a CMC Family Bible Reading booklet and join with us.
- ✓ **Become part of a Sunday School class.**
There is a class for each one of you – for the whole family, for all ages. If you do not know which one to join, speak with someone you connect well with at church and ask them which is their Sunday School class and go with them. If they are not yet a part of a Sunday School class, the buddy system still applies. Resolve to go together starting next Sunday.
- ✓ **Parents, prioritize Sunday School, Awana, Evidence for your children.**
Do not wait for them to take the lead, help them along by establishing involvement and investment in their personal walks with the Lord by setting the tone and making their participation a fixed element in your weekly schedule.
- ✓ **Connect with others through a Community Group.**
Some groups are specific for males or females, but not all. These are groups where you can hear from others and be heard. Where you can be involved in one another’s lives and practice the One Anothers of the New Testament living life together. As the name suggests, these groups are about developing and enjoying being in community. These are groups where you can learn, discuss, and grow together as you get to know and care for others. I would really encourage you to establish new connections with others through a Community Group. Again, feel free to use the buddy system and the consult the back of the bulletin for the available Community Groups.
- ✓ **Make regular use of the prayer bulletin.**
These things are nothing more than busywork unless the Spirit of God is at work. Let us be faithful to undergird these people by upholding them in prayer and thank the Lord for the way that He uses the prayers of His people to accomplish His eternal purposes.
